

# Woman's Wednesday Club 2020-2021 Scholarship Guidelines

Each year, the Woman's Wednesday Club ("WWC") awards thousands of dollars in scholarships to young women who are future community leaders.

## **ELIGIBILITY FOR WWC SCHOLARSHIP**

#### Applicants must:

- A. Be female;
- B. Be graduates of an accredited high school located in Hood County, Texas;
- C. Be college / university juniors or seniors with at least sixty (60) completed credit hours documented on transcript;
- D. Be enrolled in a minimum of 12 hours during the Fall semester during which the scholarships will be awarded; and
- E. Have university GPAs of 2.5 or higher.

## **APPLICATION GUIDELINES**

#### Each Applicant must:

- A. Meet the above eligibility criteria;
- B. Submit a complete Scholarship Application Packet, consisting of;
  - 1. A Scholarship Data Form;
  - 2. A digital or hard-copy photo of the applicant;
  - **3.** A personal statement of the applicant's goals related to the applicant's future career and the applicant's future commitment to public / community service;
  - 4. A resume including the applicant's educational accomplishments and service to the community (applicant may include both high school and college accomplishments and service); and
  - **5.** An official certified college/university transcript documenting at least sixty completed credit hours.
- C. Scholarship Application Packet components 1-4 must be submitted together. The official transcript (5) may be submitted separately, depending on university policy.
- D. By submitting a Scholarship Application Packet, scholarship winners consent to having their names, photographs, name of college, and college major published in the WWC Newsletter and published in conjunction with the WWC Style Show / Scholarship Fundraiser.

Note: The Scholarship Committee will not consider incomplete applications.
