



2021-2022 Scholarship Guidelines

Each year, the Woman's Wednesday Club ("WWC") awards thousands of dollars in scholarships to young women who are future community leaders. We offer six types of Lois G. Cleveland scholarships: Legacy, New Horizons, Granbury, Pathways, and Master Class Scholarships.

ELIGIBILITY FOR WWC SCHOLARSHIPS

Applicants must:

1. Be a female resident of Hood County
2. ***Legacy Scholarship***
 - a. Be a full-time Junior or Senior at a four-year college or university with 60 or more credit hours
 - b. Be a full-time Sophomore at a four-year college or university with 30 or more credit hours
 - c. Have at least a 2.5 grade point average
3. ***New Horizons Scholarship***
 - a. Be a full or part-time student returning to college after a pause
4. ***Granbury Scholarship***
 - a. Be a full or part-time student at the Granbury campus of Weatherford College
5. ***Pathways Scholarship***
 - a. Be a High School Senior who will be a full-time student at a four-year college or university
6. ***Master Class Scholarship***
 - a. Be a full or part-time student who has successfully completed a Bachelor's degree and is now pursuing a Graduate degree

APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Each Applicant must:

- A. Meet the above eligibility criteria;
- B. Submit a complete **Scholarship Application Packet**, consisting of;
 1. A Scholarship Data Form;
 2. A personal statement of the applicant's goals related to the applicant's future career and the applicant's future commitment to public / community service;
 3. A resume' including the applicant's educational accomplishments and service to the community (applicant may include both high school and college accomplishments and service); and
 4. ***Legacy Scholarship Only*** - An official certified college/university transcript documenting the required thirty or sixty completed credit hours.
- C. Scholarship Application Packet components 1 – 4 must be submitted together. However, the official transcript for the Legacy Scholarship may be submitted separately, depending on university policy.
- D. *By submitting a Scholarship Application Packet, scholarship winners' consent to having their names, photographs, name of college, and college major published in the WWC Newsletter and published in conjunction with the WWC Scholarship Fundraiser.*

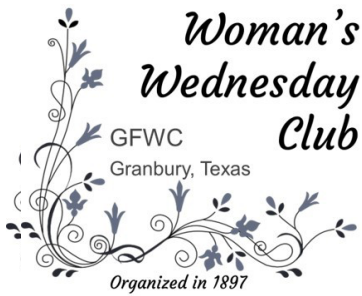
